A QUESTION

The answers are specific to his or her life, profession, and vocation, enabling a life that is fulfilling, replete with joy and contentment.

Our lives are journeys, daily filled with challenges, blessings, and frustrations. Between the moment we enter this world and the moment we leave it, we're in training as we go along. The training curriculum has a single objective: to become more like Jesus – the Master. We enter this training in response to the desire and purpose of our Creator.

OUR GATHERINGS

The Church Without Walls (sometimes referred to as

CWoW) meets in groups of various sizes throughout the Rocky Mountain Region. Groups meet in members' homes, open spaces, borrowed or rented space in public or religious buildings. Meetings take place on every day of the week, according to the needs and desires of the disciples.
