


Agnostic Uncovers Clues That Point the Way to Christ

Compelling new evidence for Christianity revealed



Thomas J. Gorman has had many titles: gang member, carnie, professional boxer, undercover agent and his most recent, Christian law enforcement administrator. Gorman's life reads like a Hollywood movie. His spiritual life parallels his secular life from an upstanding young altar boy to agnostic nonbeliever, a title he held for 26 years, to a believer firmly rooted in the Word. **To Believe or Not to Believe, That is the Question: An Undercover Agent's Quest for the Truth** (paperback, 978-1-60034-988-1) is the story of Gorman's investigation to determine "If there is any evidence to support what those Christians believe." You will enjoy his wife's role in the most important investigation of his life.

Eventually, the evidence "for Christ" was overwhelming to this one-time California undercover agent, whose career included having been shot and stabbed, more than 1,000 covert operations, and a \$25,000 contract placed on his life. Married 46 years ago in Juarez, Mexico, to his high school sweetheart, Denise, Tom readily admits that he was "Blessed by an angel." Their daughter Terri is a California school principal, and son, Tom, Jr. is a DEA supervisor.

Divided into three segments, the book comprises the author's life, a detailed account of the evidence he uncovered in pursuit of the truth (archaeology, prophecies, probabilities, textual criticism, and counter arguments to Bible critics), and answers to difficult questions such as: Is there a God? Why does evil exist? Is Jesus the only way? The text also examines the creationism vs. evolution debate. With compelling evidence that Christianity is based on truth, not myth, readers will be able to see Gorman's

conclusion and come to one on their own.
